About the workshop

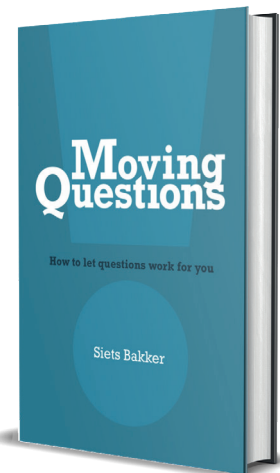

The cards can be used in many situations. During the workshop you will practice a way of using the cards for at least the following situations:

- Individual coaching
- Acquisition/intake as a professional providing services
- Self coaching
- Long distance conversation with questions
- Decision making

After the workshop you will feel comfortable enough with working with the cards. Siets will explain more about the grammar of the questions so you can create your own variations of the questions.

The last part of the workshop is used to include the symbols sides of the cards. You will learn how to mix table constellations with the questions, even if you are not a trained constellatory.
